Short project description:

The project aims to create a model of participative local planning, decision-making and project management of the Rural Sustainable Development Centre in the Mountain Village of Brusturoasa, and replicate the model in 5 other Romanian villages. Disseminate information about climate change issues in 30 communities. Increase environmental capacity in Romanian NGOs. Work with local schools, based on the SPARE educational material from Norges Naturvernforbund (School Project for Application of Resources and Energy).

Expected results:

- Model of Local Energy Planning Committee and energy project management in Brusturoasa
- Rural Sustainable Development Centre in Brusturoasa (co-funded)
- Equipment and able to run training and practical demonstrative activities on bio- and solar energy for villages, schools and local authorities
- Local Energy Planning Committees and 10 pilot project developed in other 5 locations in Romania
- Educational material and teacher's training to assist schools in implementing energy issues extracurricular activities
- Establishment of 10 pilot schools and having at least 30 schools involved in the program
- 10 NGOs with increased abilities to actively work to give relevant contribution to action plans
