Short project description:

The project aims at providing basic/primary health care solutions and services to 8 rural areas in one of Romania's poorest regions (North-East). As many as 22 292 rural patients are targeted by the project.

The need for the project is explained by the lack of service capacities in the area (e.g. 1 general practitioner to an average of 2000 patients in remote areas where transportation can become difficult in bad weather).

Expected results:

- At least 2000 school age children and 100 teachers informed about health-promotion practices (healthy eating, hygiene, anti-drinking and smoking)
- 10 'mother and baby' corners established in 10 medical facilities in the relevant area
- 4 community vehicles (1 to serve 2 communes, or 4 vehicles to 8 communes) to increase population mobility in connection with access to health services
- 1 multi-functional community care centre established in Motoseni (Fintinele) for community health care to all categories of people (refurbishment works, equipment and workers to be employed)
- 8 home-care teams established and accredited for provision of home services to ill elderly people
- 1 home care resource centre of excellence established and operational (building rehabilitation, equipment and training to employees)
- 1 or 2 exchange visits to Norway for 34 locals (mayors, doctors, staff members)
- 1 national conference on rural health in Romania
