<p>Short project description:</p> <p>Promoting mental health and improving the quality of care for vulnerable children and adolescents through (1) development of an operational framework, (2) development of training programmes.</p>
<p>Expected results:</p> <p>The new "Centre of excellence", run by Save the Children Romania, will provide children and their parents with a first of its kind community based service where they are available in a user friendly and non-stigmatizing way. The training of local staff and resource persons from institutions will also enable the project to have a long term impact on the design of these services in Romania.</p> <p>The centre will be multidisciplinary and constitute of three departments: 1/ service delivery for direct beneficiaries (children and parents); 2/ capacity building (training of personnel, supervision and technical assistance); 3/ resource development (e.g. studies, creation of materials, screening and diagnosis instruments etc.).</p>
